



Invitation to a screening interview

We, your teachers, want to be able to plan our instruction to best meet your needs. To do so, we want to know more about your experiences and needs in terms of reading and writing. We call this a *screening interview* (kartläggningssamtal).

How do we do the screening interview?

The interview is a conversation between you and a teacher. You do not have to participate if you don't want to. The conversation will be held in English and we will have an interpreter with us.

What will happen in the screening interview?

We would like to know whether you have previously read or written anything in English, for example at home or at work, or maybe at school. All such experiences are important when you learn to read and write in a new language. We will mostly talk about the time before you came to Sweden, but we will also talk about what things you want to be able to read and write in Swedish.

If you can read and write in English, you will be given some texts to read and answer questions about. You will then talk about them with the teacher.

What happens after the screening interview?

After the interview, your teachers will be given information about what we talked about. This will make it easier for them to plan your instruction.
