

Eligibility for higher education after attending the Professional dancer programme.

A pupil that studies on a nationwide recruitment programme which has its own diploma objectives has the right to obtain basic eligibility for higher education.

This can be done in many different ways depending on what programme you are studying. On some programmes, pupils can select courses within the framework of the individual options, and on other programmes you obtain eligibility through the programme specific subjects, or programme specialisation. Occasionally, pupils may also have to expand their education in order to obtain basic eligibility for higher education. On some programmes, pupils can obtain basic eligibility for higher education without expanding their education. This applies to programmes that provide English 6 as programme specific subject, or as a programme specialisation.

Professional dancer programme

In order for the pupils on the professional dancer programme to obtain basic eligibility for higher education, they must expand their education by 100 credits. The school offers Swedish 2 and 3, as well as Swedish as a second language 2 and 3 as an individual option. In addition, the school will provide English 6 as an individual option.

The pupils are also entitled to study all of the subjects that are necessary to obtain basic eligibility for higher education, as an expanded programme
